The recommended by Judo Canada minimum standards of NCCP certification are:

Dojo/Club standards

- 1) Head Coach or Technical Director or Dojo Shu (depending on the nomenclature used in your region):

NCCP INSTRUCTOR CERTIFIED

- 2) Assistant coaches:

NCCP ASSISTANT TRAINED

Tournament standards

The NCCP required minimum standards from Coaches assisting athletes in competition are listed in the Tournament Standards and Sanction Policy and are as follows:

- 1) For International projects under Judo Canada jurisdiction all coaches must be approved by Judo Canada and the Head Coach must be at the minimum **in training for the High Performance Certified status**. Assistant coaches must be at the minimum Competition Development Trained and in the process of evaluation for a Certified status.
- 2) At the National Championships the Provincial Team Head Coaches must be Certified Competition Development coach; Assistant Coaches must be **Certified Instructors**.
- 3) At other level A sanctioned events the Provincial Coaches must be at minimum trained Competition Development coach; Assistant Coaches must be **Trained Instructors**.
- 4) At Provincial level events, the minimum recommended level for a head coach is **Certified Instructor**. Assistant coaches are recommended to be at minimum **Trained Assistants**.
