

# **STANDARDS NCCP**

**The recommended** by Judo Canada **minimum** standards of NCCP certification are:

## Dojo/Club standards

1) Head Coach or Technical Director or Dojo Shu (depending on the nomenclature used in your region):

### Tournament standards

The NCCP required minimum standards from Coaches assisting athletes in competition are listed in the Tournament Standards and Sanction Policy and are as follows:

- For International projects under Judo Canada jurisdiction all coaches must be approved by Judo Canada and the Head Coach must be at the minimum in training for the High Performance Certified status. Assistant coaches must be at the minimum Competition Development Trained and in the process of evaluation for a Certified status.
- 2) At the National Championships the Provincial Team Head Coaches must be Certified Competition Development coach; Assistant Coaches must be Certified Instructors.
- At other level A sanctioned events the Provincial Coaches must be at minimum trained Competition Development coach; Assistant Coaches must be Trained Instructors.
- 4) At Provincial level events, the minimum recommended level for a head coach is **Certified Instructor**. Assistant coaches are recommended to be at minimum **Trained Assistants**.
